	e) Flooding in West Felton – considered. The Clerk was asked to write to John Bellis of Shropshire Council drainage, to convey the Parish Council's concern that the work done to remedy the flooding on Ralph's Drive has moved the problem elsewhere.		
	f) Community engagement – a written report by Cllr Ozagir was considered and it was agreed to move forward with the proposals.		
	g) Punch Bowl Inn registration as Asset of Community Value – NOTED that the owner of the Punch Bowl Inn has requested that Shropshire Council review their decision to list the Punch Bowl as an Asset of Community Value, and that a review will now take place to be completed by 17 February 2025.
